

DCPC Election Options 2018 – Memo for DCPC Board Action Item January 2018 Board Meeting

Summary:

The election committee has met twice and is divided regarding the Election Day Options for the 2018 election as detailed at the bottom of this memo. We are seeking a decision from the DCPC so we can rollout the election immediately following the January 2018 board meeting.

Agreed Timeline:

January 26: Announce Elections and Open Candidate Registrations
February 16: Candidate Registrations Deadline (11:59PM PST)
February 18: Candidate Bio's Posted on DCPC Website
February 21: Election Candidate Forum at DCPC February Board Meeting
March 5: Election Day
March 21: Announce Election Winners and Congratulate Departing DCPC Members

Agreed Sitting DCPC Member Obligation:

Publicity: Must Prove 2 Actions to Publicly Announce the Election to Their Community to Election Committee/Chair (Pitch at neighborhood association, HOA boards etc.)

Election Day Coverage: Must sign up or designate volunteer substitute for at least 2 Hour Shift of Coverage at Election day polling location.

Election Day Option #1:

1 Day at Horton Plaza. Centralized Location and voting all day from 8am to 8pm.

Election Day Option #2:

1 Day multiple locations (coffee shops etc.). Up to 4 locations 'bridging' the neighborhoods applicable in this election. (1 location for Little Italy/Cortez (on the border), 1 Location for EV North/South (on the border), 1 Location for Marina/Core/Columbia (on the border) and 1 Location at Horton (Centralized))
