This group will support activation and programming of parks and public plazas to help create a dynamic downtown for all. They will help to achieve improvements in Downtown's overall transportation infrastructure including multimodal access, vehicular circulation, parking issues, pedestrian experience and circulation, dockless vehicle regulations, bicycle routes, supporting systems, and transit systems.
 - b. 2019-2020 Goals:
 - i. Interact and coordinate with Parks and Rec Department and Clean & Safe Director of Community Enhancement to support efforts for clean and safe spaces in Downtown.
 - ii. Assist with efforts in obtaining a Park Ranger for Downtown.
 - iii. Engage with City Committee members for scooter and bike regulations.
 - iv. Work with Downtown Partnership on Placemaking and how it can benefit our community.
 - v. Understand the Downtown Mobility Plan.
 - vi. Understand how the restructuring of Civic San Diego will affect Downtown studies and the Center City Development updates.
 - c. Delegate tasks to members: Jennifer Gattey will focus on parks and programming of public spaces. Jennifer Hunt will focus on the Downtown mobility plan. Cindy Blair will focus on scooter issues and regulations. Christine Takara will focus on Placemaking.
